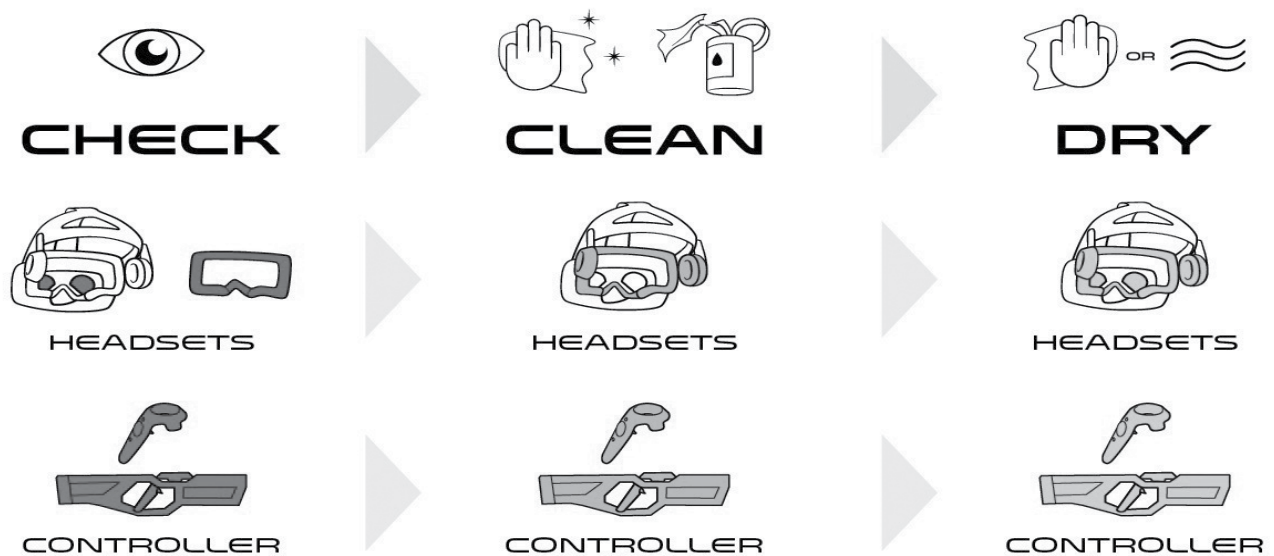
















A VR headset can act as a surface for carrying pathogenic organisms. It is important to follow the protocols to sanitize your VR equipment.

XR Viewing Protocols

- Allow healthy people to enjoy XR. Encourage the use of masks/face coverings for patrons when using headsets.
- Communicate operational procedures to patrons prior to arrival, on the library website, and through social media to establish expectations and instill confidence.
- Keep people 6 feet apart. Physical distancing guidelines may vary and can be reduced by the wearing of masks/ face coverings ensure your plan is aligned with local official guidance.
- Reduce touch areas where possible and sanitize high touch surfaces frequently.
- Signs should be placed to remind guests of physical distancing requirements.
- Provide ways to wash/sanitize hands frequently.
